“Penalty Scores”

To avoid “Penalty Scores”,
please post your score after each round of play
– whether it is 9 holes or 18 holes.

SGA Centralised Handicapping System (SGA-CHS)

The SGA CHS tracks golfers who play AT ANY GOLF COURSE IN SINGAPORE and requires that a score be posted in order for golfers to avoid being awarded a penalty score.

Golf Clubs will upload the Play List of Golfers in the SGA CHS. If you do not post an acceptable score within 13 days of playing, CHS will post a “penalty score” equal to the lowest Handicap Differential in your scoring record on the 14th day.

Golfers can post their scores anywhere and anytime using the Internet or through the SGA CHS phone App that can be downloaded on iOS or Android devices.

Instead of returning the scorecards to Golf Office to post, Members are encouraged to post their scores using the CHS APP immediately after the game. **You should not submit your scorecard to your club if you have already posted your scores directly to CHS.**
