Tampines ready to strut its stuff, Garden set for majestic makeover

n with the new and out with the old.

That would be an apt description of what transpired at Tanah Merah Country Club on the last weekend of February.

On the Saturday of February 23, the club's new Tampines course was officially opened in its full splendour.

And the following day, the club's Garden course, for long the prestigious No. 1 at the club which had hosted many world events, saw yet another closure.

But the shutdown is only temporary, probably for about 11 months before it would be revealed as yet another masterpiece with yet another massive redevelopment under the careful care of renowned course designer Robert Trent Jones Jr.

What does this mean for the club? Simple, that it always strives for excellence and will leave no stone unturned in preparing a magnificent playground for golfers of all levels and competencies because members mean a lot to the highly-esteemed club.

The redevelopment is expected take about 11 months, and the club is currently working towards reopening the Garden Course by early 2020.

It was heartening to see 65 members vote for the resolution to renew the Garden Course lease extension to 2035 at a lease premium of S\$17,272,000 before GST (deadline of 11 March 2019) at an extraordinary general meeting (EGM).

It also meant that the fabulous Garden Driving Range will be closed, but the club is making alternatives arrangements to use the range at nearby Laguna National. It was also said at the EGM that the Tampines Driving Range is only expected to be ready by end May 2019.







Once that is in place, all facilities at the Tampines layout will be readily available.

It has been nine months since the new Tampines course, designed by another world-renowned designer Phil Jacobs, has been open for play to its members and quests. And the reason for the wait for the official launch was that the club management wanted to ensure that the course and clubhouse were at their pristine best.

And nothing was spared to ensure that the launch went on smoothly. The guest of honour was none other than ESM Goh Chok Tong, a keen golfer who has graced many golf events in the name of charity.

So charity was foremost in the minds of the 175 golfers on that day, with the more than S\$570,000 raised going to three charities, namely MediaCorp Enable Fund, Down Syndrome Association and Stroke Support Station.

The presence of ESM Goh, who with club chairman Ng Kee Choe, presented the cheque to the three beneficiaries, was appreciated by all present for the ESM never fails to lend his name for charitable causes.

The 15-month long redevelopment to the Tampines layout means that it is now a championship course that has been slated to host many major events in the future.

So all in all, by 2020 the TMCC will be a favourite golfing paradise for members and guests and a drawcard for the world's best players to strut their stuff.

For the newly redeveloped Tampines, it was a major departure from Garden's Spanish architecture influences and colonial inspired façade. The Tampines clubhouse boasts a more contemporary and minimalist look and feel.

Tampines even won the award for "Best Renovated Course – Asia Pacific" by Asian Golf and that in itself was a true testament to the hard work, and effort put in by the entire club.



But the universal acclaim and praise that came along with the award also meant that there were now certain levels of expectations that should be met by Tampines at all times.

With the world watching on so intently – it was evident that it was Tampines that had everything to lose.


Fabulous new venue, superb weather make it a great day for LNY Celebration

With the Garden course ready to be redeveloped, and the Tampines layout in nearfull blossom, the new site was a perfect venue, with an ideal setting.






Blessed with perfect weather, 114 golfers enjoyed a great round at the challenging Tampines course, many holes of which bared their fangs against the not-so-good golfers.








Overwhelming Support For

Extraordinary General Meeting Friday, 15 February 2019

embers present were unanimous in accepting the offer made by the Singapore Land Authority (SLA) for a lease renewal of the Garden Course to 2035.

Sixty five members and three spouses gave the thumbs-up when they voted on the resolution to renew the Garden Course lease to 2035 at a lease premium of S\$17,272,000 before GST with the deadline set for 11 March 2019.

That despite the appeal by the General Committee for a reduced price on the lease premium not being accepted by the Singapore Land Authority.

The GC's grounds of the appeal were based on how the Garden course will not only lose hectares of land but also its current Championship Course Status due to the loss of length.

Garden Lease Renewal



The SLA considered the appeal but the Chief Valuer's Office (CVO) noted that there is currently no internationally prescribed, official minimum length that a Golf Course should be in order for it to be dubbed as Championship Course status.

After welcoming the members to the Extraordinary General Meeting at the Garden Banquet Room, club president Ho Beng Huat went to great lengths to explain the lease renewal details submitted by, and made sure that any members' doubts

were clarified, and that they were fully aware of what they would be voting for.

Mr. Ho stated that the lease renewal will be in respect of a reduced land area of 480,675 square metres, and that the



valuation of this rate was based on the exact rate used to calculate Tampines Course's lease extension premium.

He also then quickly informed all present members about the Official Opening of Tampines Course and Charity Golf Event (that happened on Saturday, 23 February 2019), and also the Garden Course Closure Game (the following day).

Mr. Ho also shared that The Garden Course Redevelopment Project is expected to take about 11 months, and the club is currently working towards reopening the Garden Course by early 2020.

Mr. Ho then left club captain Lee Lian Hong to update members on the closure of Garden Driving Range and how alternatives arrangements have been made at Laguna

Mr. Lee also informed members that the Tampines Driving Range is only expected to be ready by end of May 2019 - and for members to be mentally prepared that sunlight may be the only source of light at the range until the electric cables are in place.

After answering all questions from members, Mr. Ho then proceeded to get the members to vote on the evening's resolution.




