



The Rules of Golf of the R&A shall govern play, as modified by the following Local Rules adopted by the Committee as permitted by the R&A.

LOCAL RULES (GARDEN COURSE)

1. BOUNDARY LINES / RED PENALTY AREAS

The Red Penalty areas extend to infinity on Holes 1,2,3,4,5 and 9 and as defined beyond Greens of Hole 5 and 8.

2. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE (No Relief)

- Concrete Embankments / Stones / Rock Landscapes / Waterfall Structures and Boulder Rocks
- Boundary Fences / Protective Fence at the teeing area #01, #12 and #15
- Retaining Walls / Cart Paths lying within the margin of a penalty area.

3. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

Yellow Stakes / Lines
Red Stakes / Lines

4. DROPPING ZONE

If a ball is in the Penalty Area, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:

- take relief under Rule 17.1 or
- as an additional option, PLACE the ball on the Artificial Mat Drop Zone, if one is available.

BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Matchplay - Loss of Hole

Strokeplay - 2 Strokes Penalty

5. RELIEF WITHOUT PENALTY (Free Lift)

- (i) All Immovable Obstructions shall include:
 - Staked Trees / Lighting Poles / Open Drains
- (ii) Ground Under Repair (GUR)
 - Flower Beds marked with Flower Bed Signs
 - The Edging Grooves around the aprons or fringes of putting greens are ground under repair. If a player's ball is at rest in a groove the player may take a free relief:
 - Ball on the Putting Green (Placing ball)
 - Ball in General Area/Fairway/Rough (Dropping ball)

CONTROL OF PLAY

Golfers are to play from the appropriate Tee-Boxes according to their handicap index.

TEE HANDICAP INDEX

Blue	(Men)	18.0 & below
White	(Men)	24.4 & below
White	(Ladies)	18.0 & below
Red	(Ladies)	40 & below

PACE OF PLAY

The guided time is 2hrs 5mins (front nine) and 1 hr 55mins (back nine). Players causing delay will be directed by Marshals to play from the appropriate tee-box.

Keep up with the group in front. Speed up if gap in front occurs or invite the group behind to play through if holding up play, irrespective of the number of plays in the flights.

GOLF BUGGIES must not be driven by a person under 16 years of age.
