

The Rules of Golf of the R&A shall govern play, as modified by the following Local Rules adopted by the Committee as permitted by the R&A.

LOCAL RULES (GARDEN COURSE)

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2)

As indicated by the line between the course — side points at ground level of the White Stakes or White Lines.

2. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)

- As indicated by Red or Yellow Stakes. The fence within the Red or Yellow Penalty area is an integral part of the course. All bridges are within the penalty area.
- b. Dropping Zone for Penalty Areas

If a ball is in the Penalty Area, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found in the penalty area, the player may proceed under Rule 17, or as an additional option, drop a ball for one penalty stroke in the dropping zone provided.

The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3 and the ball must come to rest in the relief area.

3. NO PLAY ZONES (Rule 16.1)

The area indicated by flower bed signages is a no play zone that is to be treated as an abnormal course condition. Free relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 16.

The margin of the No Play Zone is determined by the edge of the grass cut to define its boundary

4. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS

a) Ground Under Repair

- i. Any areas encircled by the White Lines in the general areas are treated as Ground Under Repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1b.
- ii. Free relief is available from edging grooves, but relief is only available if a ball lies in or touches a groove, or a groove interferes with the area of intended swing (there is no free relief for stance).
- iii. Ball in general area Rule 16.1b applies. Ball on (including touching) putting green – Rule 16.1d applies.

- All unmarked concrete drainages.
- ii. All other man-made obstructions which cannot be moved without unreasonable effort in the General area including distance markers, directional signages, cart paths.

iii. Landscape garden areas and everything growing in them that are surrounded by an Immovable Obstruction are treated as a single abnormal course condition.

(c) Protection of Young Trees

The young trees identified by orange stakes. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than a penalty area and touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or the intended swing, the player must take full relief under Rule 16.1f. Objects used to support or protect these trees are immovable

5. INTERGRAL OBJECTS

The following are integral objects from which free relief is not

- allowed:

 Rock landscapes including walls and boulder rocks, waterfalls
- and railway sleepers on mounds
 Concrete drains and retaining artificial walls when located in red penalty areas and other man-made objects which include fences & netting.

6. OTHERS

The prepared area of sand on hole #8 is part of the general area and are not bunkers. There is no relief under Rule 16.3b, when the ball is embedded in the sand in a part of the general area.

CONTROL OF PLAY

Golfers are to play from the appropriate Tee-Boxes according to

PACE OF PLAY

The guided time is 2hrs 5mins (front nine) and 1 hr 55mins (back nine). Players causing delay will be directed by Marshals to play from the appropriate tee-box.

Keep up with the group in front. Speed up if gap in front occurs or invite

the group behind to play through if holding up play, irrespective of the number of plays in the flights.
