

The Rules of Golf of the R&A shall govern play, as modified by the following Local Rules adopted by the Committee as permitted by the R&A

LOCAL RULES (TAMPINES COURSE)

1. OUT-OF-BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)

As indicated by the line between the course side points at the ground level of the white stakes

2. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

As indicated by red or yellow stakes. The fence within the red or yellow penalty area is an integral part of the course. All bridges are within the penalty

3. DROPPING ZONE

If a ball is in the Penalty Area, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found and came to rest in the penalty area, the player may proceed under Rule 17 or as an additional option drop a ball for one penalty stroke in the dropping zone provided.

The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3 and the ball must be dropped in and come to rest within the relief area.

4. NO PLAY ZONES (Rule 16.1)

The area indicated by flower bed signages is a no play zone that is to be treated as an abnormal course condition. Free relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 16.1f.

The margin of the NPZ is determined by the edge of the grass cut to define its boundary.

5. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16.1)

(i) Ground Under Repair

Any areas encircled by white lines in the General area are treated as ground under repair from which is allowed under Rule16.1b.

Free relief is available from edging grooves, but relief is only available if a ball lies in or touches a groove or a groove interferes with the area of intended swing (there is no free relief for stance). Ball in general area - Rule 16.1b applies. Ball on (including touching) putting green - Rule 16.1d applies.

(ii) All Immovable Obstructions shall include:

- All unmarked concrete drainages
- All other man-made obstructions which cannot be moved. without unreasonable effort in the General area including distance markers, directional signages, cart paths. Landscape garden areas and everything growing in them
- that are surrounded by an Immovable Obstruction are treated as a single abnormal course condition.

(iii) Protection of Young Trees

The young trees identified by orange stakes. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than a penalty area and touches such a tree interferes with the player's stance or the intended swing, the player must take full relief under Rule 16.1f. Objects used to support or protect these trees are immovable obstructions.

6.INTEGRAL OBJECTS

The following are integral objects from which from which free relief is not allowed.

- · Rock landscapes including walls and boulder rocks, waterfalls and railway sleepers on mounds
- Concrete drains and retaining artificial walls when located in red penalty areas and other man-made objects which include fences and netting.

PENALTY OF BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

GENERAL PENALTY

(Loss of hole in Match Play, 2 strokes Penalty in Stroke Play)

CONTROL OF PLAY

Golfers are to play from the appropriate Tee-Boxes according to their handicap index.

PACE OF PLAY

Players playing from an inappropriate Tee-Box and causing delay will be redirected by marshals to play from appropriate Tee-Box. The Guided time is 2hr 10mins - front nine / 2hr 10mins - back nine. Keep up with the group in front and speed up play if a gap occurs. Invite the group behind to play through if holding up play, irrespective of the number of players in the flight.
