



# LADIES CLUB MATCHPLAY CHAMPIONSHIP 2026

(Handicap Index 18.0 & below)

## Terms of Competition (TOC)

Tampines Course (Afternoon)	
Qualifying Round	Sunday, 5 July 2026
1st Round	Sunday, 12 July 2026
2nd Round	Saturday, 18 July 2026
Final Round	Sunday, 19 July 2026

**Entry Fee: \$27.25 | Buggy fees for each round: \$34.88**

1. The Ladies Matchplay Championship is open to Ladies with Handicap Index of 18.0 and below as at 1 July 2026.

### 2. Qualifying Round

- The Qualifying Round is held in conjunction with the July 2026 Monthly Medal on Sunday, 5 July 2026 at the Tampines Course.
- Registration for Qualifying Round will be the Tampines Golf Office Competition Registration Counter on 5 July. **Interested members must sign-up before tee-off if they wish to participate in the matchplay championship qualifying round.**
- Entry Fee is chargeable to participants who qualified and subsequently decided to withdraw.
- A minimum of eight (8) players is required for the Championship to proceed. The Championship will be cancelled if fewer than eight (8) players registered for the qualifying round.
- In the event of inclement weather during the Qualifying Round not permitting the completion of 18 holes, the scores over the completed 9 holes shall be used. Should inclement weather prevent play for the entire session, the 8 qualifiers shall be determined based on the lowest handicap index.

3. The eight (8) players returning the lowest gross scores in the qualifying round shall qualify for the Championship proper and proceed to the first round of the Ladies Matchplay championship.

Seeding / draw will be based on the qualifying round gross scores.

Upper Half	Lower Half
1 vs 8	3 vs 6
4 vs 5	2 vs 7

Matches will be played off scratch. No handicap strokes shall be given.

Once the championship draw has been finalized, any withdrawal will be considered as a walkover i.e. no replacement / substitution. The walkover winner advances automatically to the next round.

When a match finishes all square/tied after 18 holes, players shall continue in a sudden death playoff commencing from Hole 1 until a winner is determined.

**Match Results:** Players are to cease play immediately upon conclusion of the match and report the result to the Competition Desk without delay.

4. In the event of **inclement weather** not permitting the completion of all the matches, the results of completed matches will stand.

For incomplete matches or completed matches which resulted in a tie, the players shall complete their match prior to the commencement of the subsequent round, on the following dates provisioned for completion of incomplete/tied matches.

Provision for 1st Round: Saturday, 18 July 2026 (AM)

Provision for 2nd Round: Sunday, 19 July 2026 (AM)

Provision for Final Round: Sunday, 26 July 2026 (PM)

The Tournament Director's determination of the playability of the course, due to inclement weather, and the decision taken to terminate, or resume play for the day is final.

## 5. Time of Starting

The schedules of starting times for all competitions shall be fixed by the Club Management.

Unless otherwise stated or due to unforeseen circumstances such as inclement weather, the player must start at the tee time established by the Club.

If the player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his/her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is loss of hole for Matchplay.

**Exception:** There is no penalty when the Club determines that exceptional circumstances have prevented a player from starting on time.

## **6. Pace of Play**

The “Individual Pace of Play” policy shall apply. Penalty for breaching the pace of play policy:

- a. First bad time: Reminder from the Club Officials  
(e.g. Referee, Marshal, Golf Ops Staff)
- b. Second bad time: Verbal warning from the Club Officials
- c. Third bad time: Loss of Hole
- d. Fourth bad time: Disqualification

## **7. Suspension of Play for Dangerous Situation (Note to Rule 5.7b)**

A suspension of play for a dangerous situation and the resumption of play shall be signalled using the club’s siren system. Penalty for Breach of Rule 5.7b is Disqualification.

All practice areas that are in open areas shall be closed during suspension for a dangerous situation until the Club has declared them open.

## **8. Disputes or Doubts**

The Club Official or referee shall have and make the final ruling for any tournament rule dispute.

## **9. Distance Measuring Devices (DMD)**

A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device (DMD). If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4-3.

## **10. Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA)**

All participants shall give the consent to the collection, use and disclosure of event photos for TMCC Marketing purposes including via the TMCC website, club newsletters, club magazine or TMCC social media channels.

## **11. Amendments to Conditions**

The Club reserves the right to amend the above competition conditions at any time.
