



MEN'S & LADIES' MEDALS (STROKEPLAY) TAMPINES COURSE

Qualifying for Men & Ladies Matchplay Championship Terms of Competition (TOC)

GENERAL

The competition shall be played over 18 holes, played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and with the Local Rules approved by the Tournament Director.

RULES OF PLAY

All complaints, protests and disputes shall be referred immediately to the Tournament Director whose decision shall be final.

HANDICAP INDEX

Players shall play off their lowest/current Handicap Index as of **1 July 2026**. It is the player's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his or her handicap index.

A player whose Handicap Index has Excessive Penalty Scores will not be eligible to enter the competition.

STARTING TIME AND PUNCTUALITY

Players shall start at the time and in the order indicated in the draw. No substitution of players and changes of starting times shall be permitted after the draw has been made.

- a) Golfers shall report to the starters at least 10 minutes before their tee-off.
- b) If a golfer arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within 5 minutes of his starting time, 2 strokes penalty will be added to his or her first hole.
- c) Penalty for being late beyond 5 minutes after the starting time is Disqualification.

Use of Golf Buggies is mandatory for competitions. The use of trolleys or caddies is not permitted.

FORMAT OF PLAY – STROKEPLAY

Participants must “hole-out”

Divisions / Handicap Range subject to change based on entries received.

PRIZES

There will be prizes for the Winner and Runner-up for Best Gross and Best Nett in all divisions. The Best Gross result shall take precedence over Best Nett. No player shall win more than one prize. Prize Winners will be notified by Golf Office once the prizes are ready for collection.

The “Nett and Gross “Winners” of Medals (January till December 2026) are eligible to participate in the “Medal of Medals” to be held in January of the following year, on a date to be determined.

SCORING AND RECORDING

- Players must exchange scorecards with flight-mates prior to tee-off. The player you exchange scorecards with becomes your marker.
- Please ensure that your hole-by-hole Gross Scores are clearly written, and any doubtful scores must be verified before returning the scorecard.
- Scorecards must be returned as soon as practicable but no later than 10 minutes after completion of the round to the scorecard collection staff.
- Scorecard must be signed by both the Player and Marker.
- Any scorecard not submitted will be considered a “No Return” status (NR).

INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of prolonged inclement weather, the Tournament Director reserves the right to amend a shotgun start.

In the event of inclement weather resulting in the inability for the field to complete play, the competition shall be deemed cancelled, and the entry fee will be refunded, and only the buggy fee will be chargeable.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE

The use of devices that measure only distance is permitted. A player is not permitted to carry or use devices that measure other conditions that might affect the play of the game.

SCORE POSTING FOR HANDICAPPING

Tournament Scores

- All Scores (TMCC and Away Home Club) will be uploaded by Golf Office to the SGA-CHS as Tournament Scores (T-Score).
- Non-return scores are subject to Penalty score applied in the CHS.
- Exceptional T-Scores are subject to Handicap Revision.
