

RECOMMENDED DAY TOUR PACKAGES FOR NON-GOLFING SPOUSES



East Course Itinerary: KRW \$90,000 per person

Tour fees are payable directly to the tour operator.

1. Hamdeok Beach

Enjoy soft white sand, clear shallow emerald waters, and cozy cafés at one of Jeju's most beloved beaches. If preferred, you may choose to end your tour here to enjoy the sunset and dinner at your own leisure.



2. Seongeup Folk Village

Wander through a living folk village featuring traditional thatched houses and volcanic stone walls where locals still reside. You can hear the native dialect, see old farming tools, and experience ancient Jeju customs.



3. Lunch

Enjoy a warm, hearty meal full of local flavor. You can choose between Black Pork Stir-fry or Mountain Vegetable Bibimbap



4. Gwangchigi Beach

A picture-perfect coastal spot offering dramatic views of the sea and Seongsan Ilchulbong.

Seasonal Change (Mid-December to Mid-April): The area transforms into a vibrant field of bright yellow canola flowers meeting the ocean.



5. Woman Diver Show [UNESCO Intangible Cultural Asset]

- Watch Jeju's legendary "Haenyeo" (sea women) dive into the ocean without oxygen tanks in a powerful live performance.
 - In case of bad weather or performance cancellation, the tour will visit the Haenyeo Museum instead.



6. Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak [UNESCO World Heritage]

- *(Trekking: Approx. 60 minutes)* * Climb this iconic volcanic crater, a true symbol of Jeju, for a breathtaking panoramic views of the island's eastern coastline and the emerald sea.



7. Manjang Cave [UNESCO World Heritage]

- *(Trekking: Approx. 60 minutes)*
- Explore one of the finest lavatunnels in the world, designated as a natural monument. It features fascinating geological structures, including 70cm lava stalagmites and massive lava tube tunnels.
 - Depending on weather or local conditions, this visit may be replaced with Ilchul Land & Micheon Cave.

South West Course Itinerary: KRW \$90,000 per person

1. Mt. Halla 1100 Altitude Wetland

- A Ramsar-listed ecological reserve located 1,100 meters above sea level. You can walk along the wooden boardwalks to observe unique alpine flora and enjoy the closest, most majestic view of Mt. Halla without hiking.
 - Depending on weather or local conditions, it may be replaced with Fantasy Forest Gotjawal or Camellia Hill.



2. Jusangjeolli Hexagon Lava Cliff [UNESCO GEO Park]

- Designated as Natural Monument #433, the sedramatic, black hexagonal stone pillars resemble a massive folding screen. Witnessing the beautiful ocean waves crashing against these unique volcanic formations is mesmerizing.



3. Cheonjyeon Waterfall

- Known as "The Pond of the Gods", this magnificent three-tiered waterfall flows through a lush, dense forest. According to local folklore, heavenly maidens used to bathe here, giving the place a mystical charm.



4. Well-being Buffet Lunch

- Enjoy a healthy buffet lunch prepared with fresh, seasonal local ingredients and vegetables. It is light yet satisfying, accommodating various tastes and dietary needs.

5. Gotjawal Forest OR Herbal Foot Bath Therapy

- **Gotjawal Forest:** A rare forest formed on volcanic rock where tropical and temperate plants coexist, offering a surreal, peaceful primeval forest experience.
- **Herbal Foot Bath:** Relax your feet and mind with a warm foot bath infused with Jeju's natural herbs, accompanied by a soothing cup of tea.
 - *May be adjusted or excluded depending on seasonal conditions and daily weather.*



6. O'sulloc Green Tea Field

- Wander through endless, beautifully manicured green tea fields. You can visit the tea museum to learn about Korea's traditional tea culture and enjoy premium tea-themed desserts while taking memorable photos.



7. Songak Mountain

- Featuring a rare double crater volcanic topography, a stroll along the coastal trail offers spectacular, panoramic views of the ocean, Mt. Halla, and Sanbangsan.



8. Bomunsa Temple at Sanbangsan

- A peaceful Buddhist temple nestled at the foot of the impressive, bell-shaped Mt. Sanbangsan. It offers a striking combination of a massive mountain backdrop and a vast, open ocean view.



★ Optional Drop-off: Dongmun Traditional Market

At the end of the tour, you can request for a drop-off at the Jeju's oldest traditional market, famous for its vibrant evening food stalls.

Please note: This is a drop-off only service at the market. There is no guided tour or designated tour timing; participants are free to explore the market independently at their own pace.
